Eugenie Loyer Aged 18-20	Attractive, carefree and self-assured young girl, later a drained mother-of-two caring for her mother. Well-spoken.	P15-16 P59-61
Sam Plowright Aged 21-23	Jaunty, genial. A lovable cockney. His aspirations and strong opinions are finally lost in the reality of daily life.	P10 'Cheers' to p11 'You didn't tell me that'. Long speech on p17 (p66-68) additional if needed
Anna Van Gogh Aged 18	A repressed, intrusive force, constantly interfering and judging. Ludicrous, irritating and funny. Dutch accent.	P40- top42 P54
